Icebreaker: Have you ever had a flood affect you?

**Read: Genesis 6:9-22**

1. What do you notice in this passage? Is there anything from the message that stands out to you?
2. What can we say about Noah? (6:8-9, 6:22)
  - a. Which of these qualities are to imitate?
  - b. Notice the repetition of how Noah did what God commanded him (6:22; 7:5, 9, 16). Talk about the importance of obeying God.
  - c. Author Jerry Bridges talks about "Respectable Sins." What are some areas where believers today fail to obey God?
  - d. What is a step of obedience you need to take? How can the group help you?
3. Share questions you have about the ark. Let people in the group help with some answers.
4. What is good about God's judgment of evil?
  - a. Read 2 Thessalonians 1:6. What does it mean that God is just?
  - b. How is God's justice a comfort and a help to us?
  - c. Read Deuteronomy 32:4. Apply this verse to the flood. Then apply this verse to your own life.
5. How does the flood show God's faithfulness?
